



Carnival Guidelines

We're really looking forward to seeing your entry for this year's carnival. Here are a few notes to help you prepare for an enjoyable day.

You will need to:

- ▶ Nominate a Marshal for your entry
- ▶ Ensure the safety of all your participants
- ▶ Ensure no water, eggs or other objects are thrown
- ▶ Comply with instructions from Carnival Marshalls
- ▶ Make sure your entry is alcohol free before and during the Parade
- ▶ Ensure Carnival collection buckets are returned to your nominated Carnival Association contact at the end of the parade
- ▶ Prepare for any weather. Sun cream, water and raincoats may all be needed!
- ▶ Bring your own smaller buckets to collect money easily on the way round

We will:

- ▶ Contact you one month prior to the event to ensure everything is running smoothly for you
- ▶ Contact you in the week running up to the Carnival with details of:
 - ❖ Where you need to meet
 - ❖ Your number and position in the Parade
 - ❖ Your nominated Carnival Association contact for the day
 - ❖ How to hand in your collection buckets and banner
 - ❖ Your drop off point and/or your designated meeting point* for the rest of the day

* Large groups will have their own meeting point on Hatch Grange which can be used all day

Carnival Route

Procession starts at 1pm

Start → Quob Lane → Across Chapel Road → Hope Road →

St James' Road → High Street → **Finish** →

Hatch Grange - Jubilee Gates (Hatch Lodge Entrance)

Arena Events Start approx 2pm
