As you can see from the above, we have finally reached over a thousand residents in West End – a fantastic result. This has taken a great deal of effort but it is worth it to reach a greater number of residents quickly.

Recently we have helped the victim of Domestic Violence move from her home address to a refuge. This decision was not taken lightly but after several months of supporting her in other ways this proved to be the safest way for her and her children to re-build their life without a violent husband/father in their lives. A number of juveniles have been dealt with for minor public order at one of our Primary Schools. Speaking to one of the children with their mother has brought to light a number of welfare issues that we are assisting them with.

Long term safeguarding help has been given to an elderly lady whose bank accounts were being accessed by two males who were known to her. They had taken advantage of her good nature and abused the trust she put in them. Her accounts are now secure, she is being assisted by adult services and the males are being dealt with by our colleagues.

Advice / Info -

The current hot topic is Phantom Debt fraud, this is just the latest method for criminals to take money from their victims. You will be cold called and told that there is an outstanding debt owed by you, bank accounts will be quoted and threats made to send bailiffs to your address to get bank details from you, I think you know the rest! Please, please, please if you are in he least bit concerned by any call you get take five seconds to think about what is the very worst that can happen if you give a complete stranger your bank details over the phone.

Other Information -

If you should need to make a report of an issue / incident, please ensure you call 101. Or if you wish to report either, **criminal damage**, **theft** or **theft from a vehicle** you can do this online here Please do not report incidents by replying to this alert or emailing an officer direct - we cannot take reports this way. An officer may be committed, on leave, or off sick and the message will sit in their inbox with no one else would be aware of it. It is important to ensure the call taker is aware you want to make a report of the incident - not that you wish to pass a message to us. They can then create the report, so that the incident is available for every department, officer and staff to see. A decision will then be made as to whether an officer needs to deployed and whether this needs to be urgently or not.
