NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

HAMPSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

THE HAMPSHIRE (EASTLEIGH BOROUGH NO.10) (PARISH OF WEST END – PART OF FOOTPATH 501) PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2022

The above named Order, made on 14 April 2022 under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 will extinguish part of West End Footpath 501 commencing at a junction with West End Footpath 11b and continuing southwards to a junction with West End Footpath 510 at Ash Drive.

Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Head of Countryside Access, Hampshire County Council, The Castle, Winchester, SO23 8UJ, or via e-mail to row.notices@hants.gov.uk quoting reference:- PPO 5181 no later than 20 May 2022. Please state the grounds on which they are made.

The personal data you provide in any representation will be treated in accordance with Data Protection Legislation, and may be published in a decision report, be disclosed to other interested parties, including the landowner (or their representatives). It may also be made public if the matter is referred to the Planning Inspectorate. Your data will be retained for a maximum period of two years from the date that the application is resolved. The legal basis for our use of this information is the compliance with a legal obligation – Highways Act 1980.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Hampshire County Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed order. PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT
MODIFICATION ORDER 2022**

This Order is made by Hampshire County Council (“the authority”) under Section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the part of the footpath described in paragraph 1 below is not needed for public use.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (“the 1981 Act”) because it appears to the authority that the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the stopping up (as authorised by this order) of a highway hitherto shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Eastleigh Borough Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at West End and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order, and thereupon the Hampshire Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way (dated 15th December 2007) shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way, and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in the Schedule to this order.
2. Notwithstanding this Order all Statutory Undertakers shall have the same rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 as they have hitherto enjoyed.

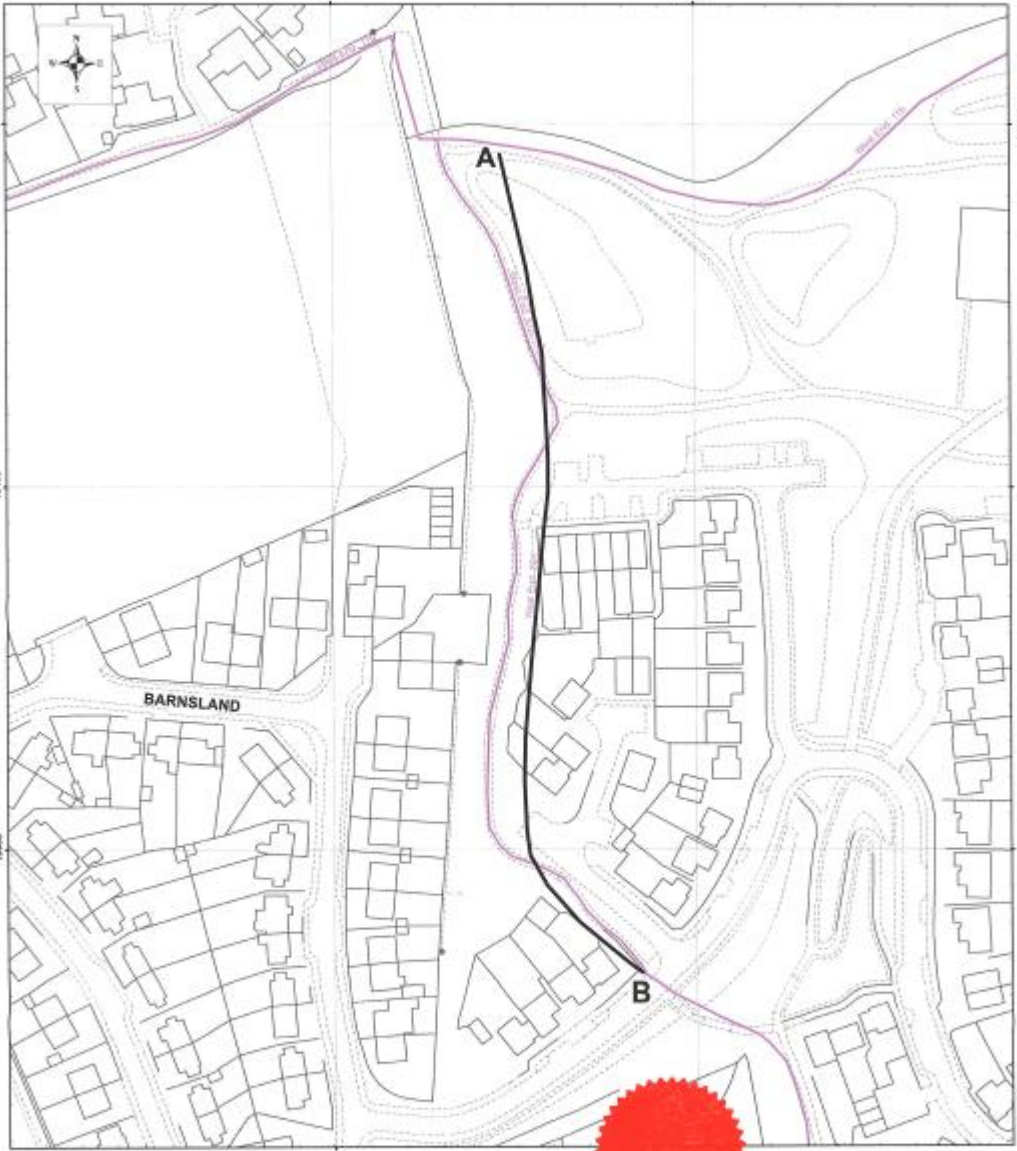
